Flexjet 25 card accesses Bombardier jets from Bombardier Flexjet fractional fleet, which includes Learjet 40, Learjet 45, Learjet 60, Challenger 300 and Challenger 604.	25 hours (\$119,900 to \$149,900 for Learjet 40 and \$235,000 to \$309,900 for Challenger 604, depending on program). Skyjet card also available in 50- and 100-hour denominations.	Card members can save up to 20 percent through plans that black out peak travel dates. Unused card balance can be applied toward purchase of share in Flexjet fractional program. Upgrades and downgrades of aircraft can be purchased. Buyers of 25-hour card qualify for up to two free hours of flying at low-demand times. Under company's "preferred positioning" program, empty legs are posted and customers can book them at highly discounted rates, and request alternate departure or arrival airports. Combination Cards enable customers to have access to two different aircraft. CitationShares fractional customers can buy time on the card program to supplement their fractional hours. Hours must be used within 12 months.

Aircraft range from Cessna Citation CJ2 to Gulfstream G550.	\$100,000 (Silver), \$150,000 (Preferred Plus), \$250,000 (Gold).	Offers "preferred" fleet of aircraft with average age of four years, and "select" fleet 10 years old and older. Members can switch among aircraft sizes and fleets on trip-by-trip basis with no exchange fee. Silver and Gold Travel Cards don't expire and money is fully refundable. Preferred Plus card must be used within a year, is nonrefundable and provides discounts for use of preferred fleet. Silver membership has two-hour minimum for flights; Gold and Preferred Plus memberships have one-hour minimums.
