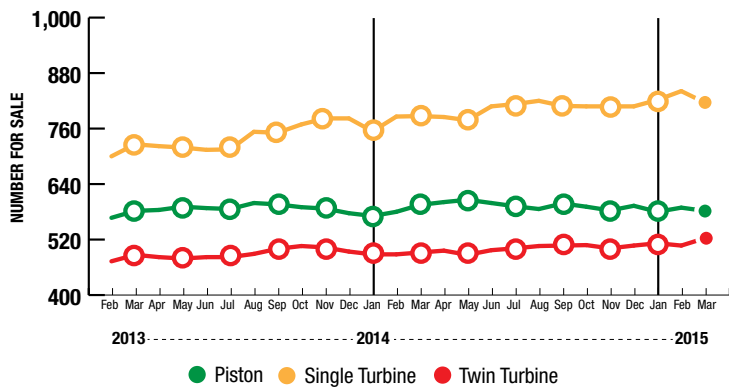


HELICOPTERS FOR SALE

As this table suggests, the overall rotorcraft market has been relatively stable, largely because certain missions—such as medevac and search and rescue—absolutely require helicopters. The executive transport category—and especially the market for preowned single- and twin-turbine helicopters—has been weak, however.
